

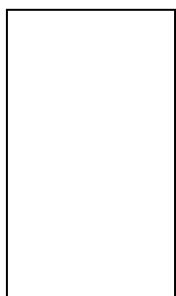

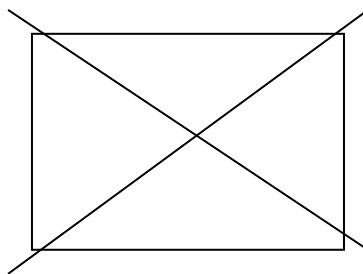
Confirmation Banner Square

Confirmation is a significant sacramental celebration for the entire parish community. All of us rejoice with you as you complete your initiation into our Catholic family. Many of you designed small banners for your First Eucharist to be hung in the church. You are asked to do the same for this sacrament.

You will be given a square that is 9" by 12". It is to be designed so that the 12" is the length (up and down) and 9" is the width (across). Refer to the picture below.

You must have your Confirmation name on the square.

You may use any materials you would like, such as felt or decorative fabric, to create your square. Please think about what the sacrament means to you and then select the symbols which represent your ideas.

We would prefer that you use **only** symbols - no words. **The only word on the square would be your name.** This is more typical of Church art.

All banner squares are due by May 11, 2018. Because we need lead time to prepare the larger church banners, it is imperative that you keep this date. If you do not have a square prepared and turned in at this time, it probably will not be part of the Confirmation banners. You may turn them in to Parish Office as soon as they are ready, but again, they must be returned no later than May 11, 2018.
