



Sunday Reflection

The eager and immediate response from Peter, James and John, and Andrew in today's reading draws us into their joy, but tension and confusion are lurking just beneath the surface. While these disciples are the only ones who will be privileged to some of the most complete revelations of Jesus' power and purpose, they are also the ones who will most seriously misunderstand Jesus and will fail him at key moments in Jesus' life.

- 1. What does this passage tell you about call and response?
- 2. Recall a time when you shared the enthusiasm of the disciples in this Gospel passage.
- 3. Has your enthusiasm for Jesus ever been tempered or even absent? Why or why not?

SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD. JAN 21


Pope Francis has declared that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is to be devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the word of God "that the life of our people be constantly marked by this decisive relationship with the living word that the Lord never tires of speaking to his Bride" (*Aperuit Illis*, 2).

The faithful have shown reverence to the bible as the inspired word of God since ancient times. The enthronement of an open bible has often served as a symbolic invitation to delve into the sacred text as the source of our spiritual life. You might use this short ritual from the American Bible Society to enthrone the Bible at home, in schools, and with RCIA or Bible Study groups.


