Someone may ask, "Why do I have to go to Mass when I can just pray to Him my own way?" You can pray and worship to God whenever you feel like it. In fact, it is encouraged! However, God asks us to pray in a communal and Eucharistic way - at Mass.

At Mass, we worship God as a community, pray together for our needs, collect gifts for the needs of our city, ask for forgiveness from each other and make peace with others in the community. We get together for so many events as family and friends- weddings, graduations, birthdays, concerts, the Grey Cup!-why shouldn't we celebrate the most important event of all.

Most importantly, Jesus called us to worship together at the Last Supper when he commanded, "Do this in memory of me". And God commanded us to "Remember the Sabbath Day and keep it holy" (Exodus 20:8). In keeping with Christ's resurrection, the Church celebrates the Sabbath on Sunday, which for Christians is a "little Easter". There are so many occasions in our lives that are important and where YOUR presence is noticed. There is no more important person than God and we honour HIM when we attend Mass.
